***Fully vaccinated** are those who have received **all required doses** of either *Sinovac, AstraZeneca, Johnson & Johnson, Pfizer, Moderna, Sinopharm, or Sputnik*, **no less than 14 days before departure**. **Children under 12** travelling with parents are exempted from this requirement. **Children from age 12 but not older than 18** are also exempted if they are travelling with parents. Without parents, they need a certificate of vaccination showing **one dose** of vaccination. **Those infected and have recovered** may present a certificate of recovery together with a certificate of vaccination showing **one dose** of vaccination.

****Eligible Countries/Territory:** Australia, **Austria**, Bahrain, Belgium, Bhutan, Brunei Darussalam, Bulgaria, Cambodia, Canada, Chile, China, Croatia, Cyprus, Czech Republic, Denmark, Estonia, Finland, France, Germany, Greece, Hungary, Iceland, India, Indonesia, Ireland, Israel, Italy, Japan, Kuwait, Laos, Latvia, Lithuania, Luxemburg, Malaysia, Maldives, Malta, Mongolia, Myanmar, Nepal, Netherlands, New Zealand, Norway, Oman, Philippines, Poland, Portugal, Qatar, Romania, Saudi Arabia, Singapore, **Slovakia, Slovenia**, Sri Lanka, South Korea, Spain, Sweden, Switzerland, UAE, UK, USA, Viet Name, Hong Kong, Taiwan

*****Exception:** The “21 days” requirement does not apply to travellers who reside in Thailand and travel to eligible areas for a **short-term visit**, provided that they have not been outside of the areas before returning to Thailand.

******Sandbox areas** include, *among others*, **Bangkok, Phuket, Krabi, Phang-Nga, Surat Thani** (*Koh Samui, Koh Phangan, Koh Tao*) and **Chonburi** (*certain districts only*). Sandbox travellers must arrive **through international airports** at Suvarnabhumi, Don Mueang, Chiang Mai, Phuket, Samui, U-Tapao or Buriram (chartered flights only). At present, domestic flight transit to Sandbox areas via Bangkok is only possible for Samui (through designated flights only).
